



Background

Peldon Rose were appointed by the Musicians Benevolent Fund after a four-way pitch in order to completely design, project manage and construct their new offices at Britannia Street, WC1.

The Musicians Benevolent Fund purchased a former warehouse which Peldon Rose ultimately transformed into a dynamic workspace carrying out a full Cat A and Cat B refurbishment of the building together with the inclusion of full air conditioning and dynamic open plan spaces, which are predominantly white and simple with natural oak timber floors.

How we delivered

The ultimate brief for the project was to deliver a dynamic open environment for Musicians Benevolent Fund that changed their culture dramatically from their existing offices and put their 'not for profit' organisation into the 21st Century.

The shared spaces are large, fresh and airy and are a focus to the Organisation. The Boardroom, major staff breakout area and meeting space has been constructed around a courtyard, thus allowing light to flood into the space.

The environment is truly engaging and has freed the mind of the Organisation beyond belief allowing it to go forward with a sense of freshness and lightness for the future.
