



Background

As a leading global charity World Society for the Protection of Animals (WSPA) needed to expand and create a more flexible workspace. With a mission to build a united global animal welfare movement Peldon Rose were able to advise WSPA to relocate from the thirteenth floor of their existing building down to the first floor, thus doubling their floor plate and benefitting from Landlord's rent-free periods and contributions. The environmental credentials of the project were key.

How we delivered

Peldon Rose delivered a fully environmental project for WSPA specifying materials in accordance with BREEAM together with recycling and reusing a number of the core elements within the existing space, namely ceilings partitioning and doors. All of the existing furniture was carefully audited and reused. The overall feeling of the environment when complete is relaxed and has a sense of community about it together with injecting elements of the brand through the use of graphics at the ends of each of the work spaces thus allowing power, voice and data to flow readily throughout the office.
